

ICOMAM 2019 Conference, Kyoto (Japan) Call for Papers:

In 2019, ICOM will have its triannual General Conference in Kyoto (Japan) from 1 to 7 September.

At the same time, ICOMAM will have its International Conference 2019.

On 2 and 3 September 2019, there will be an on site meeting for ICOMAM. On 4 September there will be a joint session with ICOM-Costume.

The sessions will take place from 13:00 – 17:00 hrs.

We are inviting you to submit a paper proposal for the ICOMAM 2019 International Conference and the joint session with ICOM-Costume.

ICOMAM is an International Committee of ICOM which specialises in Museums and Collections of Arms and Military History and is dedicated to the study and preservation of arms, armour and militaria.

ICOM-Costume is an International Committee of museum professionals and costume historians from all over the world committed to the study of all aspects of presenting, preserving researching and collecting apparel.

This call for papers is meant for both the ICOMAM sessions on 2 and 3 September, as for the joint sessions with ICOM-Costume. At the joint session on 4 September, three papers will be given by members of ICOMAM and three by members of ICOM-Costume. Later that afternoon from 15:00 to 17:00, there will be the opportunity to meet our colleagues of ICOM-Costume in an informal encounter.

The general theme of the ICOM General Conference 2019 is:

Museums as cultural hubs, the future of tradition.

ICOMAM introduces an own topic for their sessions:

Authenticity in Cultural Differences: Concept or Object?

Papers can be given for both topics.

Duration of a paper is maximum 15 to 20 minutes.

The **deadline** for paper submission is **1. 4. 2019**.

To submit your paper, please send an abstract of your study proposal (maximum 220 words), with a biography attached (maximum 110 words) to: p.vanbrakel@nmm.nl

We also need your:

- Name, title, ICOM card number
- Your institution, your function

- The option for an ICOMAM session or the joint session with ICOM-Costume.

The abstract should be submitted in .doc or .docx file format. The paper abstracts will be reviewed and selected by a special editors committee of the organisers.

The conference will be held in English.

It will result in a peer-reviewed publication. All articles will be published in an assigned style guide, if submitted before deadline (to be announced).
