

CIMUSET Survey: call for ideas about Museum Definition

We understand the ideas of changing/adding Museum definition, because we do not thought that the present ICOM museum definition is ideal.

For many decades, ICOM museum definition, last amended and approved in Vienna 2007, has been the result of considerable achievements of ICOM members and committees: the inclusion of an “education” mission beginning in 1961, the expression “in the service of society and its development” during the Round Table of Santiago, Chile, in 1974 and the acknowledgement of “intangible heritage” in 2007.

CIMUSET decided to participate with its members in this open, transparent and consultative process lunched by ICOM for the next two years to develop, discuss and debate new ideas for Museum Definition.
