# **Programme and call for Papers**

## Session A: Intangible Heritage

12 November 2025, 14:30-16:00

We will explore the positioning of museums with Egyptian and Sudanese collections as dynamic entities capable of safeguarding intangible heritage in an ever-evolving global landscape. In the face of rapid transformations driven by technological progress, shifting demographics, migration flux, mutations in social patterns, and environmental changes, the safeguarding of intangible heritage is of significant concern worldwide. We will discuss continuity and revitalisation of intangible heritage, the preservation of intangible heritage and how to safeguard the ancient Egyptian and Sudanese collective cultural legacy for both today and tomorrow.

#### Call for Papers

The themes of CIPEG in Dubai follows the three sub-themes of the ICOM General Conference. Depending on our registrations we will divide the papers between session A and B. Session C together with UMAC will also encompass the themes Youth Power and New Technologies. For the theme of Session A, Intangible Heritage in connection with Egyptian and Sudanese collections, some possible topics can include handicrafts, arts and rituals.

We aim at papers being 10 min. and 5 min. discussion. More details will follow.

# Session B: Youth Power and New Technologies

12 November 2025, 16:30-18:00

We will dive into the pivotal role of young people in forging the Egyptian and Sudanese museums and collections of tomorrow. Youth is the power engine that is needed to move ahead and navigate an ever-changing world, while museums, and not least the ones with Egyptian and Sudanese collections possess a unique potential, offering young people a window into the past, a tool for reflection on the present, and a platform for shaping the future.

As communities undergo swift transformations driven by technological advancements, combined with the rise of distance learning, there is an opportunity for museums to tap into the potential of new technologies to create new forms of expression, enhance audience engagement and visitor experiences, and improve operations.

#### Call for Papers

We call for papers that may include either of the themes or a combination of them both. Some possible topics can include: How can museums integrate new technologies responsibly? How can technology enhance content creation and sharing while preserving authenticity? What is the role of the young staff and community in the technological development?

We aim at papers being 10 min. and 5 min. discussion. More details will follow.



#### Session C: Ancient civilisations and the contemporary academy

13 November 2025, 14:30-16:00

We will investigate the changing understanding of the materiality of ancient civilisations, particularly ancient Egypt, through the contemporary academy and other forms of cultural production and consumption. By 'contemporary academy' we understand a modern organisation that does research, either a museum or a university. We want to discuss how new technologies are transforming the generation and transmission of knowledge and how a new wave of emerging scholarship requires a sound contemporary and ethical framework for both knowledge generation and dissemination.

## Call for Papers

We call for presentations on the changing nature of our understanding of and engagement with the materiality of ancient Egypt (and other ancient civilisations) and how this is manifest in both university museums and public museums. Some possible topics can include:

- Is the nature of Egyptology teaching and research in our university sector changing? If so, what are the drivers and what are the emerging new paradigms?
- How has technology changed research and public engagement with the materiality of ancient history? Does this fundamentally change the reception history in our academies and our public museums?

We aim at papers being 10 min. and 5 min. discussion. More details will follow.
